



White Mountain Cable Construction, a Verizon authorized contractor, will soon begin construction on Trayer Road, Kathryn Lane, Robbin Road, and Kristin Lane in the Canton Highland section of town. This construction will last for approximately two weeks. Verizon is taking the opportunity to place new conduit in the neighborhood in advance of the proposed asphalt re-surfacing by the town. All of this work will be done in the town's public right of way. During construction, there is a possibility that homeowners will see altered terrain in front of their homes, but within the public right of way. Verizon's goal is to perform our work as unobtrusively and quickly as possible. Verizon will restore the altered terrain to its original condition. However, the time-period for restoration will depend on weather conditions. The work that we will be performing will lay the structural foundation for Verizon to come back at a later date and place underground fiber optic cable facilities in the neighborhood.
