



Effective January 1, 2012 Walgreens will no longer be a participating provider with Express Scripts!

Q. What does that mean to you?

- A. If you currently have a prescription at Walgreen's pharmacy come January 1, 2012 you will no longer be able to fill that prescription if you participate in our Blue Cross Blue Shields medical insurance as our pharmacy vendor is Express Scripts.

Q. Can I transfer my prescriptions to another pharmacy?

- A. Yes you can, **you can move your Walgreens prescriptions to another pharmacy now and avoid having to change pharmacies at the end of the year.** Simply ask your new pharmacy to call Walgreens or take your current prescription bottle to your new pharmacy.

Q. What about mail order?

- A. You can still use Express Scripts as the mail order provider. Also, **now is a good time to consider moving the medications you take on an ongoing basis to the Express Scripts Pharmacy. There's no extra cost and your prescriptions are delivered free. And with auto refills, your medication will always be right where you need it ... at home.**
