This correspondence is being sent as a reminder to renew your annual Summer Recreational Camp Permit for calendar year 2023 through the Canton Board of Health. I have already received some applications and will begin reviewing next week. State regulations 'Minimum Sanitation Standards for Recreational camps for Children, State Sanitary Code 105 CMR 430.00' requires this annual renewal in order to receive a license to operate.

To apply for a Permit or License go to the Town of Canton permitting website at <https://cantonma.viewpointcloud.com>. If you filed for a camp license last year, you can use the same log in credentials. If you are new to the system you will need to set up an account. Applicants should file with the Board of Health at least **90 days prior** to the desired opening day. Documents can be uploaded to the permit site for review prior to the start of camp. If you wish to submit all documents in one file, use the "Additional Documentation" section to upload one complete file. **Please do not upload Personal Health Information or staff CORI/SORI records on the permit site.** This information should be submitted directly to the public health nurse by secure email at mgoldstein@town.canton.ma.us or via a secure link from your organization.

It is important for the camp organizer or designated contact person to call or email Public Health Nurse, Meg Goldstein at (781) 821-2942 or via this email to review your documents **three weeks prior** to the start of camp and to schedule an onsite opening day inspection. This inspection must be complete before a camp receives a license to operate by the Local Board of Health. We appreciate your cooperation.

Please mail or drop off your payment in the amount of \$50.00 payable to the Town of Canton. Payment can be submitted in the form of check or money order (**no cash**). The online permit system is not able to accept payment at this time. Your application and license will not be completed until payment is received.
