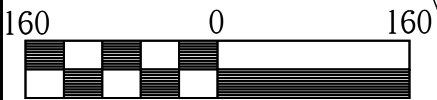


Pequitside Farm

Pequitside Property Use Guidelines

1. Open from dawn to dusk unless issued event permit
2. Dogs must be leashed at all times
3. Clean up dog waste and place in receptacles provided
4. No dogs allowed on playing fields
5. Do not feed, approach, or touch wildlife
6. No alcoholic beverages

Pequitside Farm is 33.5 acres of open space with approximately 1 mile of walking trails located on Pleasant Street in Canton, Massachusetts. In 1971 the Town purchased the farm and the focus of the property turned from agriculture to passive and active recreation. It is home to the oldest surviving house in Canton, the Tilden House.
