## Memorial Hall Exterior Restoration

Applicant: Town of Canton - Facilities

Project Cost: \$2,500,000

CPA Funding Requested: \$283,506



- ❖ Memorial Hall was constructed in 1878 as a memorial to Canton's Civil War dead. The building is the seat of Canton's town government. It has been in continual use for over 140 years and is on the National Register of Historic Places
- ❖ In FY 21, CPA funds supported a study of the historic building to document issues and develop cost estimates for rehabilitating and preserving the building envelope in a manner consistent with the Department of Interior Standards.
- ❖ Based on the results of that study, the Town is seeking \$283,506 in CPA funding to undertake architectural design work as part of the \$2.5 million Memorial Hall exterior preservation project.
